



Inés C. Iglesias Canle,

Professor of Procedural Law at the University of Vigo since 2020. Previously, she has held various teaching positions at the University of Santiago de Compostela and Vigo. She graduated in Law in 1992 and acquired a Doctor of Law Degree from the same University in 1998. In addition to her teaching activity, she has carried out research and teaching stays at German Universities (Freiburg, Cologne...), Italian Universities (Florence, Sapienza, Bari...) and Latin America. He has been visiting professor at the Sapienza University of Rome (2021) and Foggia (2018).

Principal investigation lines:

- a) Judicial Organization and Civil Process: Expert evidence, reconciliation, civil and commercial mediation, judicial office, modernization of the judicial administration, digital records and the telematic process, resource rights and the resources system.
- b) Criminal Process: Corporal interventions, corporal registrations and inspections, DNA tests, pre-constituted evidence, the procedural guardianship of gender-based violence victims.
- c) Administrative procedure: Resources system, cassation appeal, urbanism and environment.
